The Central Library of the Rochester Public Library is accepting applications for a **temporary part-time Maintenance Worker**. This is a temporary position to work through June 30, 2018. Anyone meeting the following qualifications is invited to apply:

Graduation from a standard grade school course; **PLUS** one (1) year of experience as a worker or trainee in one or more of the standard building trades (plumbing, carpentry, painting, electrical or mechanical).

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Minor repairs to windows, floors, doors, walls and other parts of buildings;
- Performs semi-skilled work in masonry, carpentry, electrical and painting operations;
- Helps in the installation and repair of plumbing, heating, ventilating and electrical equipment and systems;
- Cleans carpets, strips and waxes floors;
- Removes snow from sidewalks and roadways;
- Performs minor maintenance and repair tasks on gasoline and electric motors;
- Performs miscellaneous tasks requiring manual labor.

- Knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions of one or more of the mechanical or construction trades;
